REGULATIONS

for use of the cloakroom in the Jagiellonian University - Medical College buildings.

The Regulations define the general conditions and rules of using the cloakroom located in the Jagiellonian University-Medical College buildings.

§ 1

The cloakroom in the Jagiellonian University-Medical College buildings is used to store outerwear and umbrellas and is free of charge.

§ 2

The cloakroom staff in exceptional cases, at the request of submitting to the store and after signing the appropriate statement (Annex no. 1 to these Regulations), may accept to store other things, if their sizes and shapes are not threat to the other objects and clothes or cannot be self destroyed.

§ 3

- 1. The cloakroom staff is obligated to store, with due diligence, entrusted things, in particular, to keep them without deterioration.
- 2. The cloakroom staff and administration personnel are not responsible for things, documents etc. left in the pockets of clothing.

§ 4

- 1. The cloakroom does not accept for safekeeping money, valuables, and animals, dangerous objects, threatening the life or health. Malodorous objects or those with a strong smell will not be accepted either.
- 2. The person who leaves the things mentioned in paragraph 1 without the knowledge of the employee of the cloakroom, does so at their own risk and is solely responsible for their action.

§ 5

- 1. The cloakroom staff gives a person who leaves things in cloakroom a token which is a proof of accepting things for safekeeping.
- 2. The cloakroom employee may return things to the person only after the presentation of their token.
- 3. The cloakroom employee is not obliged to verify the identity of the person collecting things.
- 4. A person who lost token is obligated to notify about this fact the cloakroom employee as soon as possible to avoid collecting thing by another unauthorized person.

In case of accepting for safekeeping in the cloakroom things mentioned in § 2 their collection is possible after presenting the proof of identity by the person retrieving things, in order to confirm the data with information entered in a statement.

These Regulations enter into force on the day 1 st March 2014.
